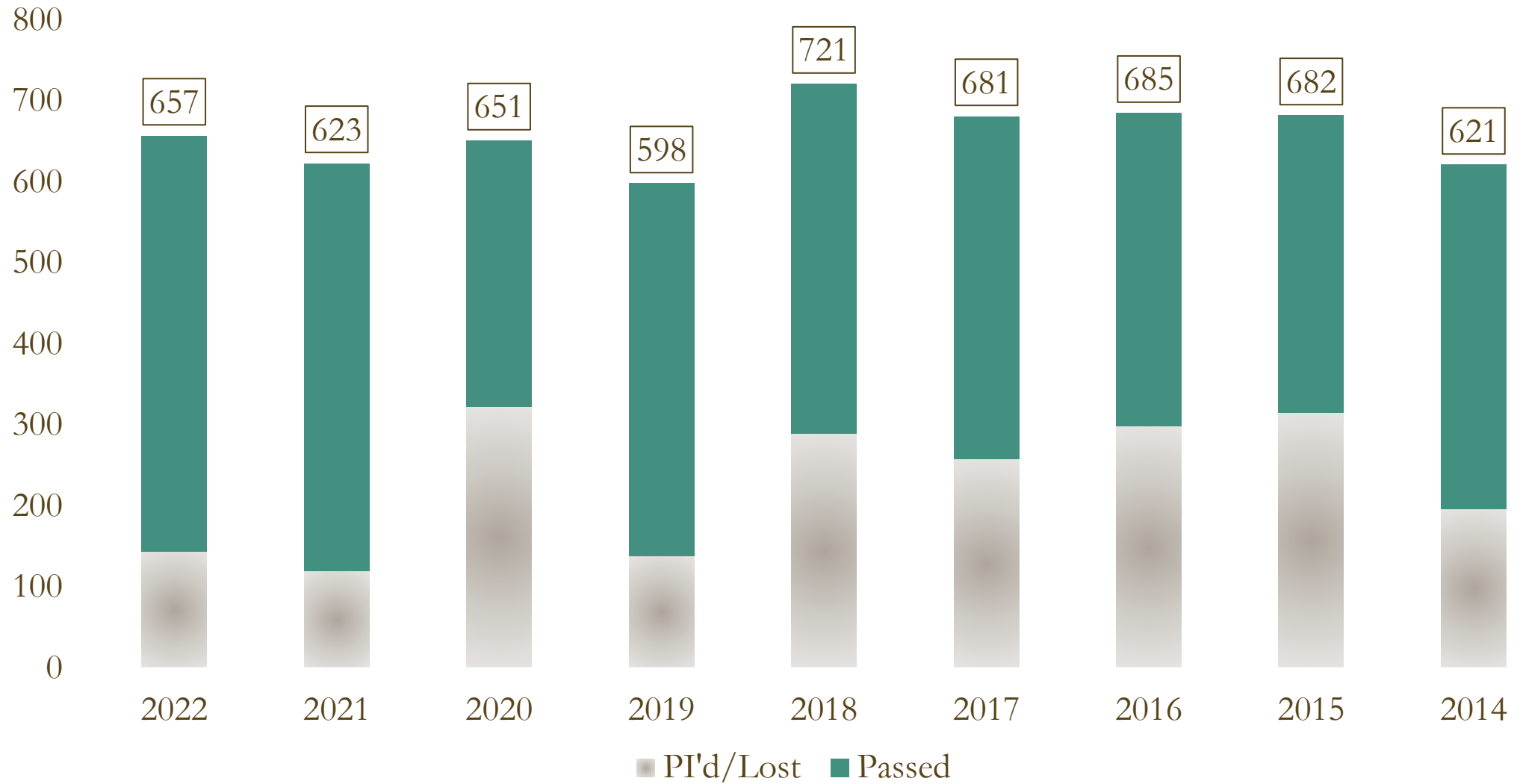

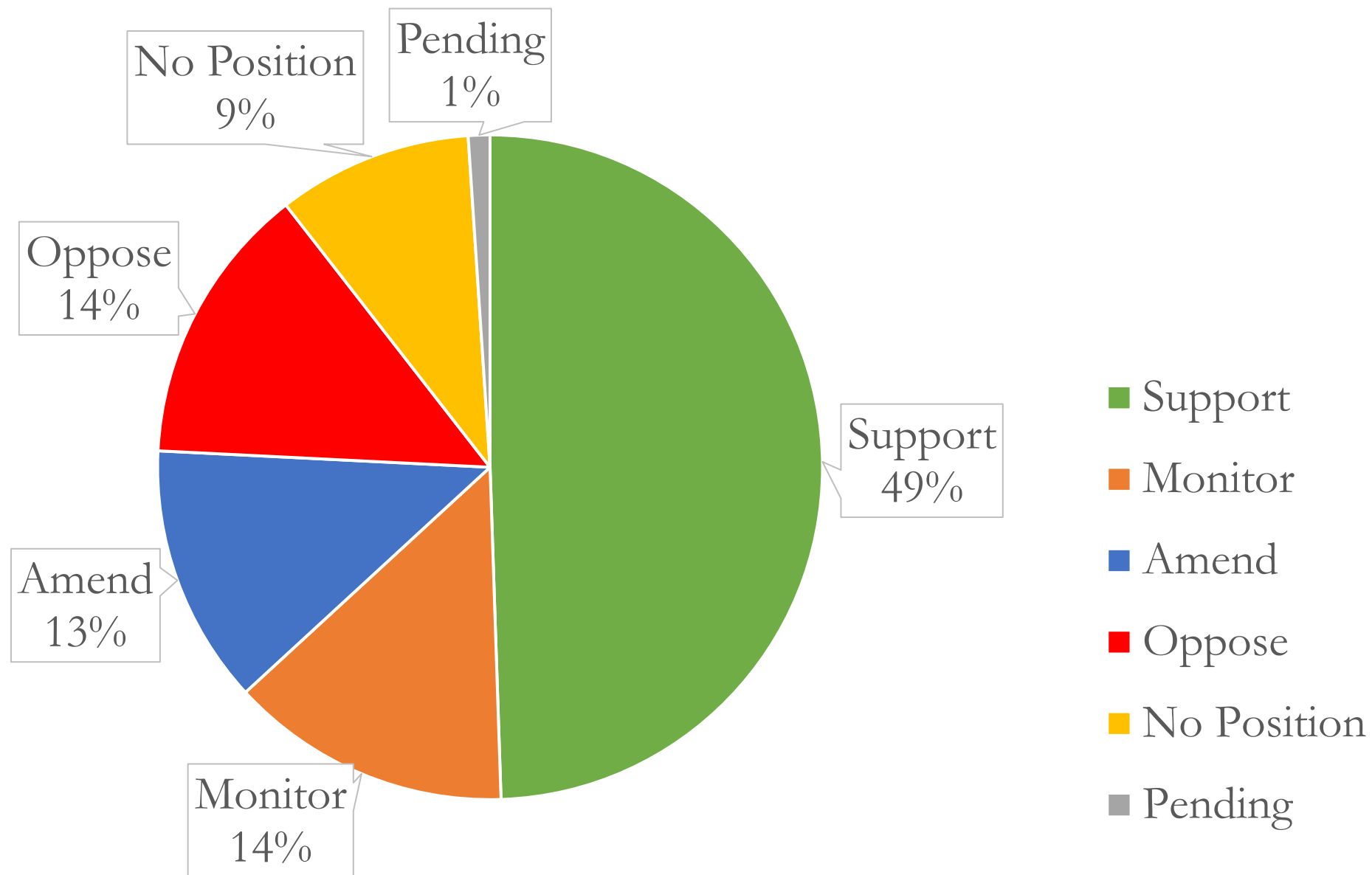
2022 Session Bills

Total	657	144	513	78%

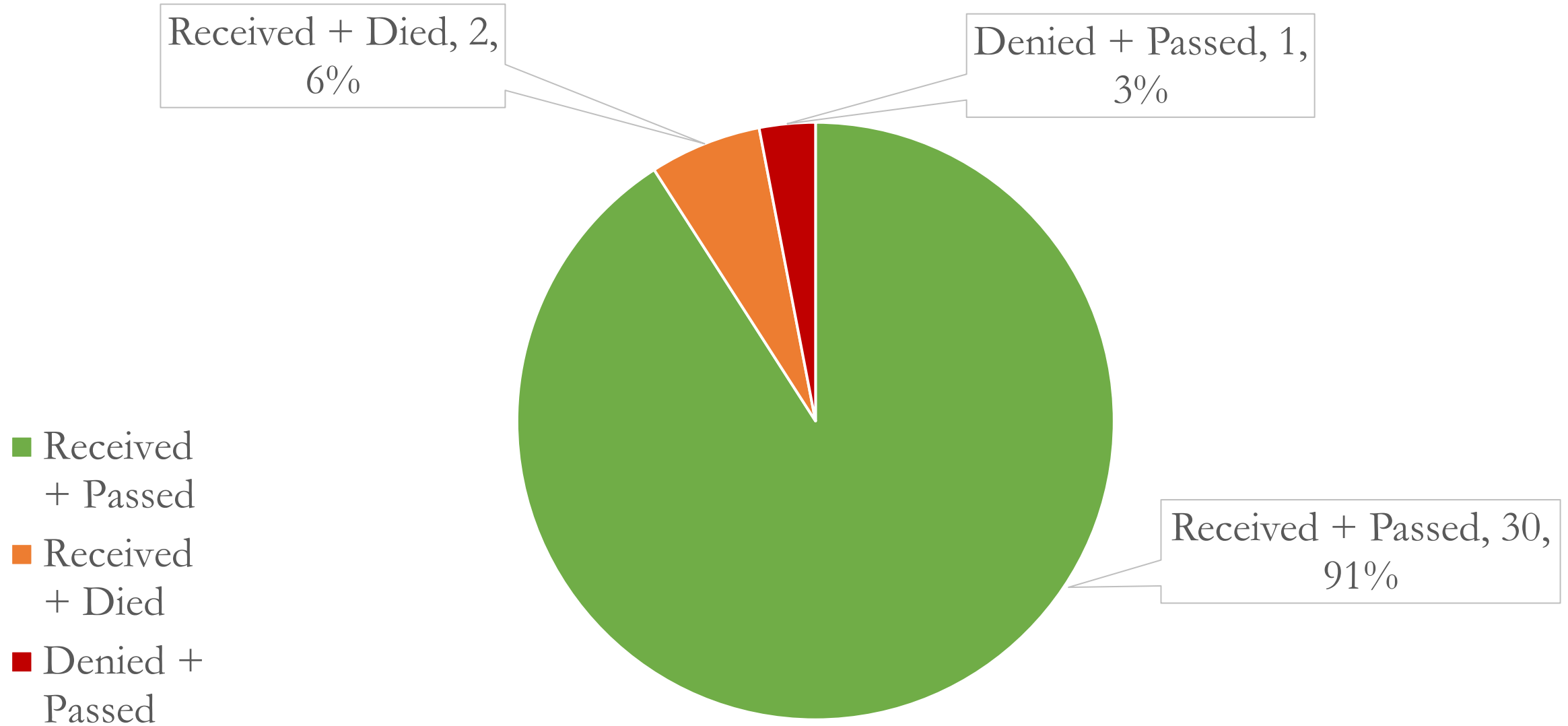
Historical Comparison



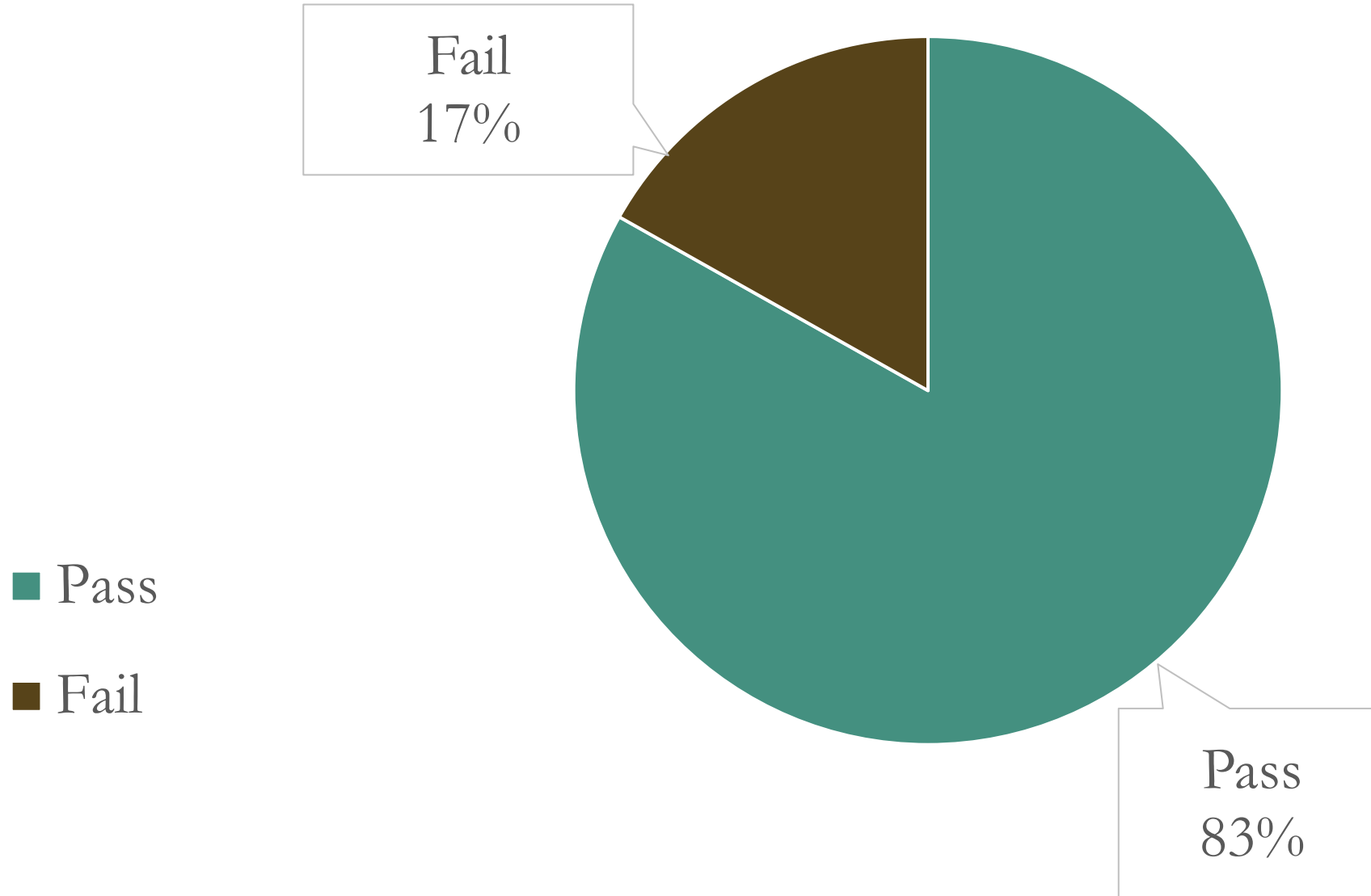
CCI Bill Positions | 95 Bills



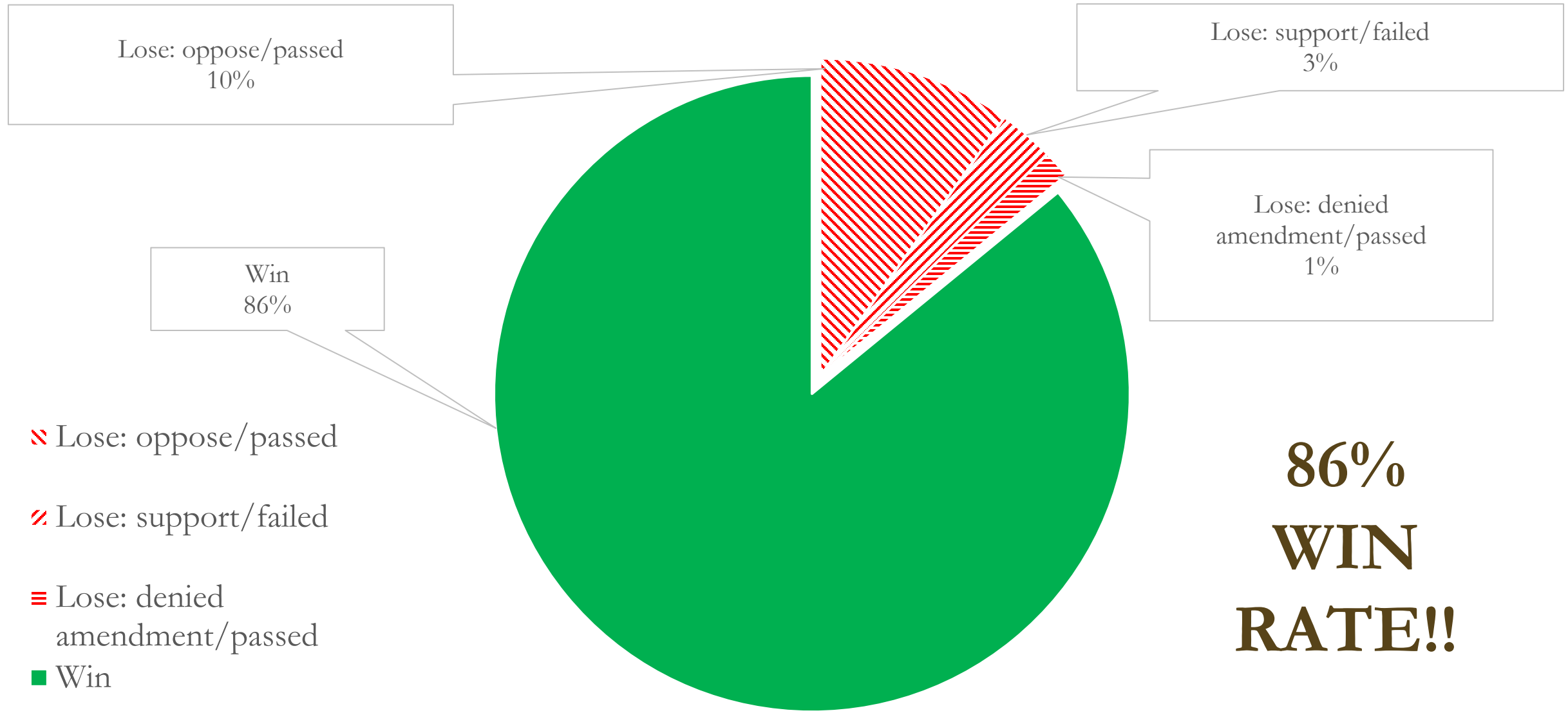
Total, Amendment Outcomes | 33 Bills

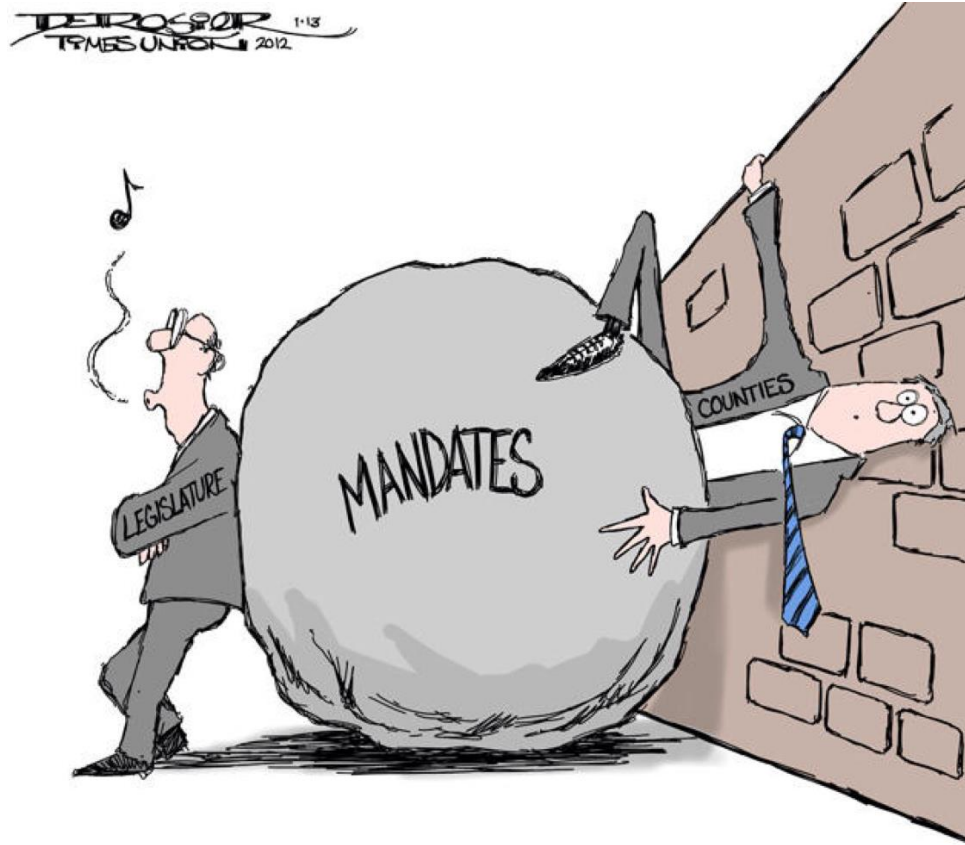

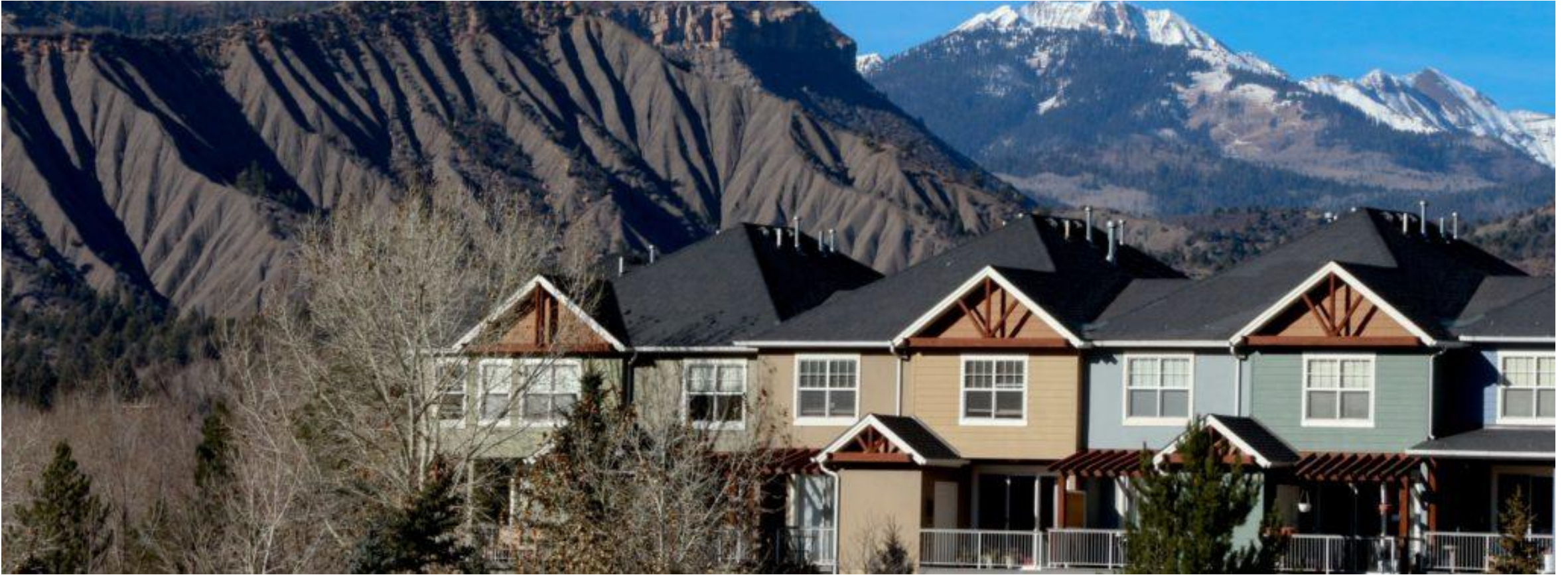
