

    - Increases understanding of who mental health authorities are, how they came to be, and why they are relevant to counties.






#### Rural and Frontier County Leaders



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# Impact of MCOT



- Connecting Clients to Services
  - MCOT links clients to appropriate mental health services
- Support for Law Enforcement
  - Provides a tool for law enforcement during mental health emergencies
  - Helps officers handle situations they were not equipped for previously
- Positive Feedback

## **CCBHC certification**

The CCBHC model requires:

- access to 24/7/365 crisis response services
- strong financial and quality metric reporting
- formal coordination with primary and other care settings
- linkage to social services, criminal justice/law enforcement, and educational systems
