I began my public service career in the summer of 1979, as an entry level employee of the Assessor's Office. Sixteen (16) months later I was appointed the Assessor. I continued that position for thirty-eight (38) years. Those experiences and challenges brought both pain and joy. I held leadership positions, including Legislative Committee Chair (1998 – 2014), from 1988 – 2018. I continue to learn and grow.

I learned after that experience (2020 – 2022), as an independent fee appraiser in the private sector. I specialized in Estate assignments, ranches, farms and water rights. I help regulate appraisers in Colorado in 1990 – 1996, serving as on original Board member of the Board of Appraisers. I have obtained my Certified General appraisal credential in 1992 – present. I will return to the appraisal world after my term ends. I can speak appraisal, with experience on both sides of the counter.

I have a forty (40) year commitment as a volunteer on a multi-county water conservancy district. It serves five (5) counties in the Upper South Platte Drainage Basin (parts of Clear Creek, Douglas, Jefferson, Teller, and all of Park).
